## JEFFCO'S 2014-15 PRELIMINARY ENROLLMENT INCREASES

Jeffco Schools has released 2014-15 enrollment figures that show the district's enrollment has increased.

The 2014-15 membership shows 86,574 students, an increase of 563 students from the 2013-14 school year. Last year, Jeffco saw an increase of 469 students. (Refer to chart). These preliminary enrollment numbers include students in facilities and may be adjusted based on the outcome of review by the Colorado Department of Education.
