## New Members Are Sworn In to the Jeffco Public Schools Board of Education

**Golden, Colo. (November 20, 2015)** – At last night's Board of Education Meeting, Jeffco Public Schools bid farewell to outgoing Board members Jill Fellman, John Newkirk, Julie Williams, Ken Witt, and Leslie Dahlkemper, and welcomed the five new Board members elected earlier this month.

New Board members Brad Rupert, Susan Harmon, Ali Lasell, Amanda Stevens, and Ron Mitchell spoke to an audience of community members in the Jeffco Education Center on Thursday night. After taking an oath of office administered by Philip J. McNulty, Chief Judge of the 1st District Court, the Board of Education selected Ron Mitchell as President, Ali Lasell as Vice President, and Susan Harmon as 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President. In addition, the Board appointed Amanda Stevens as Secretary, and Brad Rupert as Treasurer of the Board of Education.

Following the audience's applause in recognition of both the incoming and outgoing Board members, the new Board of Education laid out its vision for the future, outlining, among other things, a theme of collaboration, respect for differing views, and the shared priority of teacher performance and compensation.

"We will disagree at times, but we can listen and consider diverse opinions in a respectful manner," commented Board President Ron Mitchell. "This board will continuously deal with an unlimited list of student needs and limited resources to meet those needs. We will have to prioritize and allocate resources wisely to maintain and improve the quality of education that we provide to our students."
